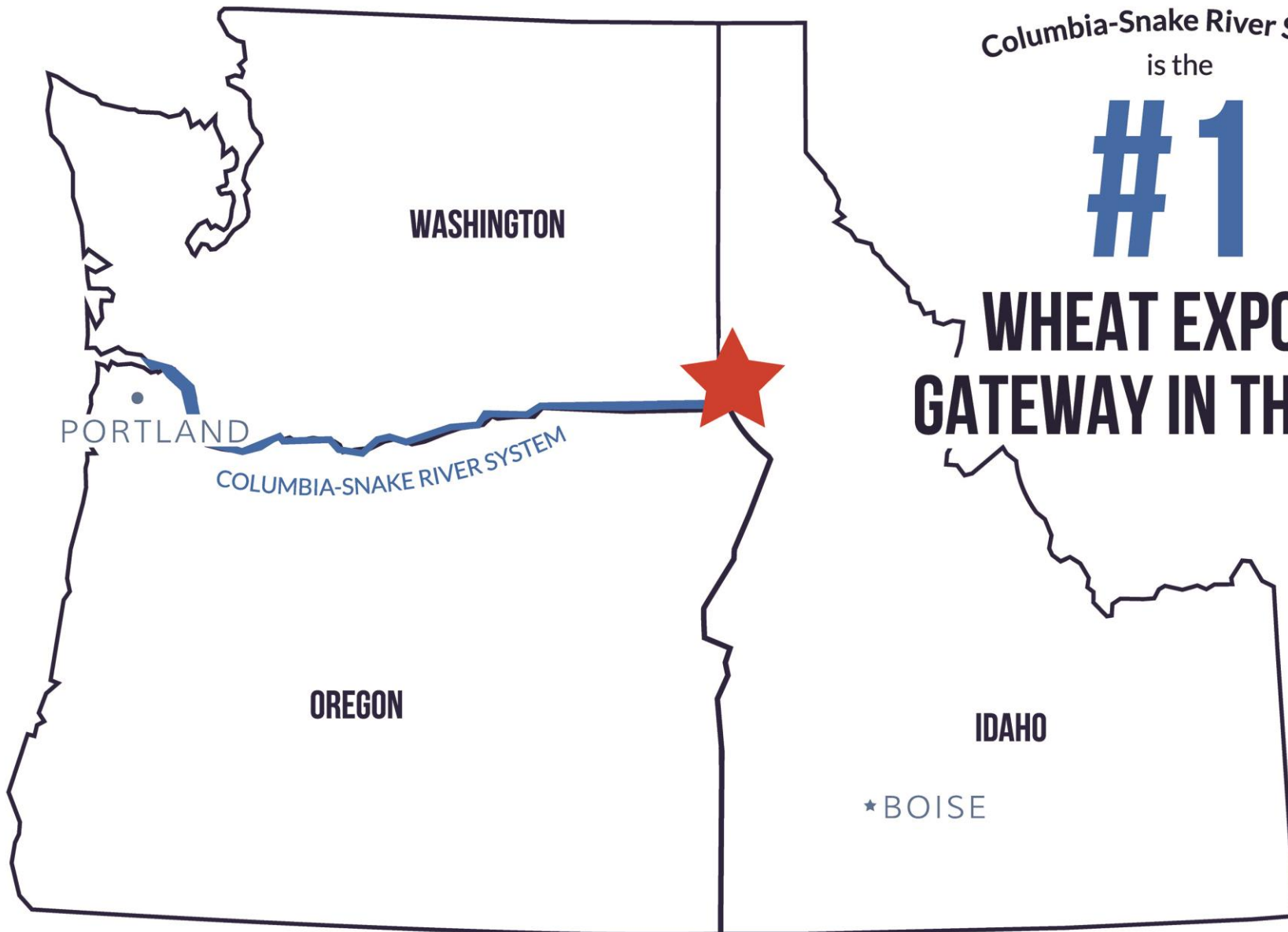

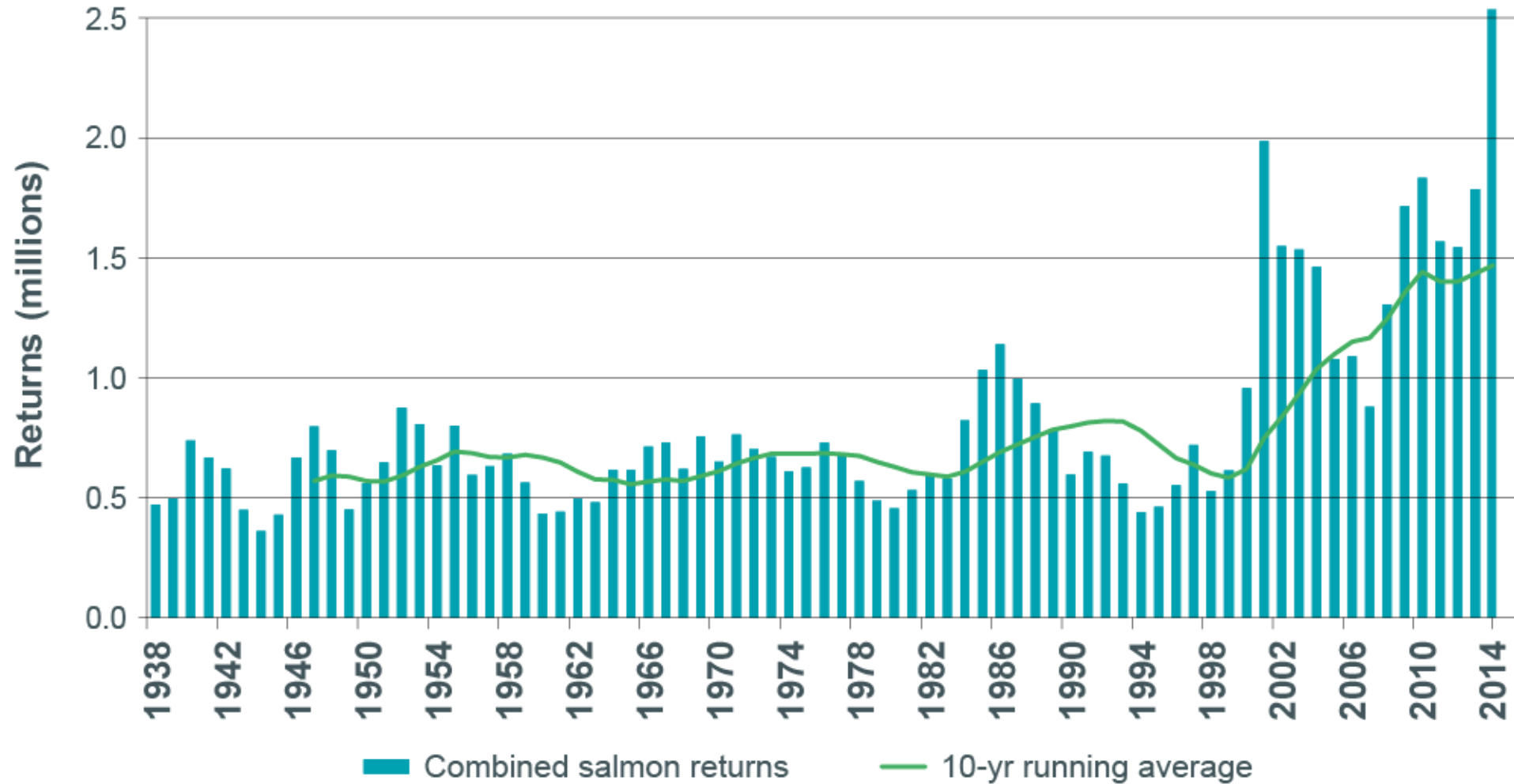
Advanced fish passage systems help ensure high salmon survival at the dams.



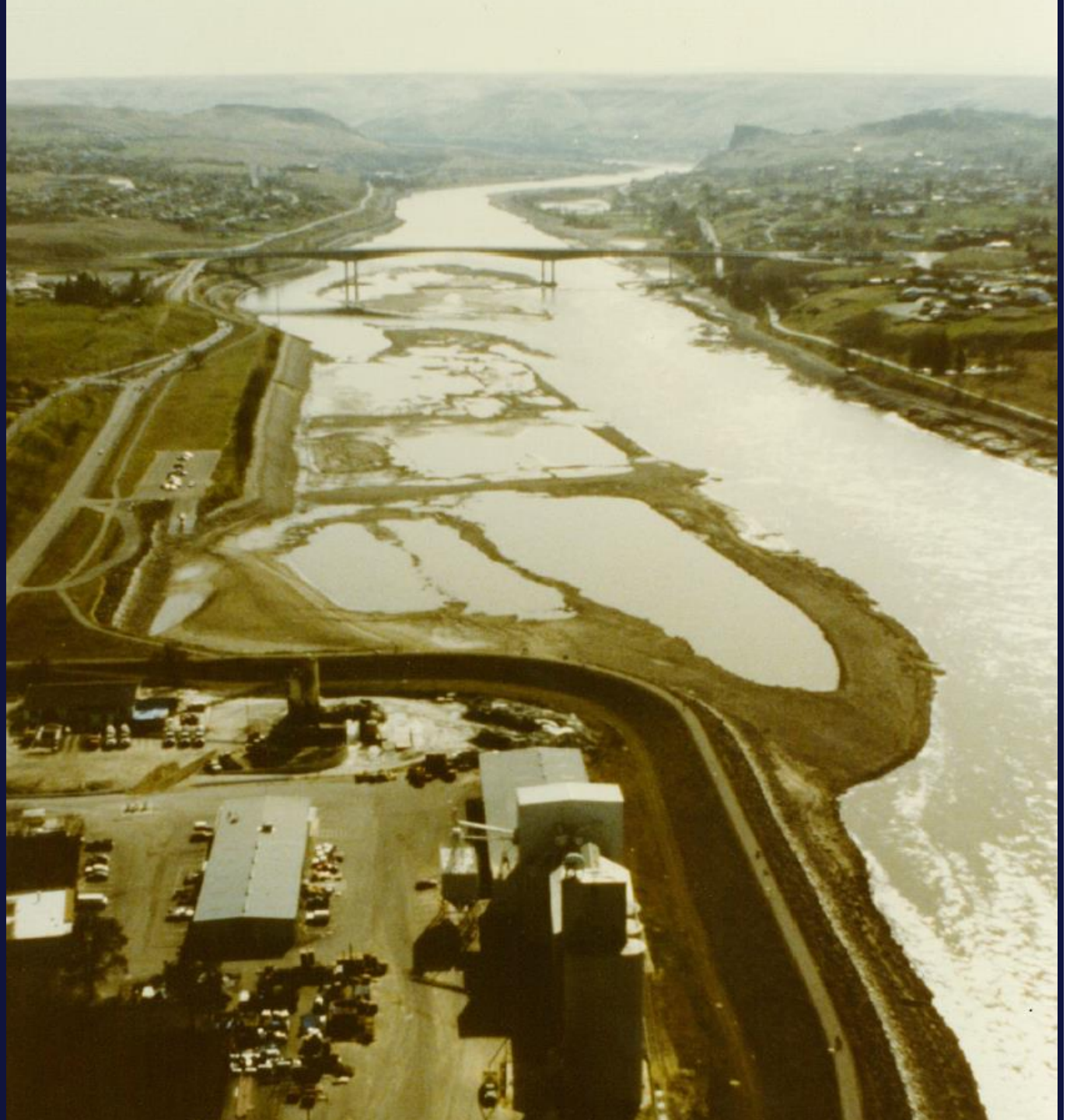
DIVERSE RECREATION
